SUBJECT: Control of fire risk. Preventive measures concerning **spray cans**.

Dear Madam, Sir,

As part of our efforts to control the risk of fire on board, we have strengthened our preventive measures regarding spray cans. These instructions are applicable upon receipt of this letter, for your own teams and your sub-contractors.

General Instructions:

- Apply the instruction of the SDS (safety data sheet).
- Store spray cans in a dedicated area free from heat sources.
- Never expose cans to more than 50°C.
- Do not keep deformed or rusted cans.
- Before use, check absence of any nearby source of ignition (eg hot work operations).

Instructions applicable on vessels:

- **No storage in wooden boxes.**
- Storage permitted in **dedicated metallic boxes** (namely chemical or hazardous product storage cabinets). The cabinet must be movable (casters).
- The location of the cabinet is defined with the CDA ship management team.
- The cabinet must be labelled with company name and telephone contact.
- The can usage must be declared to safety central station on the jetty, by the drafting of the document AUB (sec5 HSE 014 – AUTORISATION FOR THE USE OF GAS BOTTLES Flammables).
- The used cans must be disposed in compliance with the waste procedure in the dedicated bins on the jetty.
